


PRIMARY ZONE PLAN

The curb appeal of the home needed to be as captivating as the **creativity** present in this **family**. With the help of traces and final concepts, lines and **organic** elements were primary with this family.





This architectural floor plan illustrates the layout of the first floor. On the left, a Powder Room is shown with a double door, a toilet, and a sink. The **greenery** wall built-in to the architectural detail serves as a beautiful focal point for anyone entering the space.






The main floor's seating area has a **formal** setting for any guests coming over. It is clear **open concept** from the kitchen so as to maintain any conversation.







To bring practicality to the architectural design, I chose to **extend** an area of the wall detail into a **table**.




PRIMARY ZONE PLAN



In the lounge area of the bedroom the detail is **reflected** in the mill-work of the fireplace.






